We had 7 members participate in "Show and Share".

As a "get acquainted" exercise, three members gave a comparison of themselves to a spool of thread they had chosen, as requested by Anita Brozik, program chairman.

Margaret Manns presented a program on "Tips for Quilters". She gave a receipe for removing blue markings from fabric. She showed a pattern grid that could be purchased at Sewing Machines Plus and how she keeps pantographs in a three-ring binder. She purchases her 6,000 yard thread spools at Texas Specialties in Dallas TX. Margaret showed us a thread picker from Soft Touch Thread Pic, poster binder clips to clamp and hold quilt backing on the quilting machine, how to use scotch bright to clean wheels on quilting machines and how to use packing paper for backing or stabilizer when doing applique. She spoke on how to deal with wavy boarders and how to make flange binding. Her last demo was how to square up the large pieces of fabric for backings.
